This year marks a major step forward for the Austrian Journal of Earth Sciences: We enlarged the group of editors by Martin Zuschin (current president of the Austrian Palaeontological Society) and restructured the group to facilitate and speed up manuscript processing. Michael Wagreich is now the editor-in-chief of the journal; associated editors are Bernhard Grasemann, Hugh Rice and Martin Zuschin. This broadening and structuring of the group of editors was necessary to handle 2 issues per year of the AJES.

The first successful steps have also been made towards admission into the Science Citation Index of Thomson-Reuters. Starting with 2008, AJES is in the evaluation phase and is included into the Science Citation Index-Expanded (SCIE) including the Web of Science. We hope this positive trend will continue. For this we need your continuous support as authors, reviewers and subscribers to the Austrian Journal of Earth Sciences.
